Compressed Bergen is one of my favorite conventions. It is actually quite simple. With four+ card support to a major suit, responder bids 2 NT with any hand that contains 6 high card points or more. Compressed Bergen merges 3 bids (3C, 3D, and 2NT) into one 2NT bid, thereby freeing up those bids for other uses. Moreover, using 2NT in this way makes defensive bidding by the opponents more difficult. It eliminates lead directing doubles and creates more doubt regarding the strength of responder's 2NT bid. Some players may elect to use this convention for very weak hands with a ruffing value when not vulnerable..

Opener's Rebids: Opener's rebid tells responder what kind of hand he needs to make game.

3C -- opener needs a mixed raise from responder

3D -- opener needs a limit raise

3 of the bid major -- opener needs an opening hand

3 of other major -- opener has 18+ AND a stiff/void somewhere. Responder can ask about that shortage by bidding 3N (indicates slam interest)

3NT -- opener has 18+ with no stiff/void

4C -- void showing exclusion Blackwood

4D -- void showing exclusion Blackwood

4 of other major -- void showing exclusion Blackwood

4 of bid major -- pre-emptive. Opener has 6+ trumps and minimum hand. A Law of Total Tricks bid.

After opener tells responder what he needs to make game, responder normally sets the contract at 3 or 4 of bid major. If responder has slam interest, he can show that interest as follows:

3S (when Hearts are trump) -- asks opener to show shortness if he has any

3N (when Spades are trump) -- asks opener to show shortness

4C -- delayed splinter

4D -- delayed splinter

4 of other major -- delayed splinter

If opponents interfere over the 2N response, opener bids as follows:

Pass -- opener's rebid would have been "under" the opponent's bid (example: 1S -> Pass -> 2N! -> 3D -> Pass!). The Pass says opener would have bid less; in this case, that must be 3C.

Double -- opponent "stole" my bid.

Other bids above opponent's interference -- same meaning as if opponent had passed.

Stratified: A=2000+; B=750-2000; C=0-750 (Stratified by pair or team average)

Strati-flighted: Flights A/AX play together: A=5000+; AX=0-5000; Flights B/C/D play together: B=1250-2000; C=750-1250; D=0-750

Knockouts: Bracketed by average masterpoint holdings of all team members. Compact KOs limited to 4 members only. KOs may be handicapped.
