



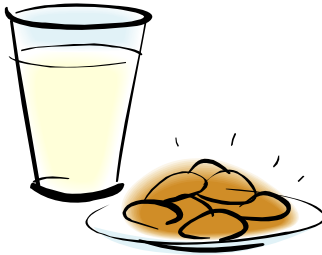

Welcome to the 2010 Denver Rocky Mountain Regional! On behalf of District 17 and the Denver Bridge Unit, we hope you will enjoy our tournament.

Stop by the registration desk, pick up a restaurant guide, sign up for some labels, and receive an elk patch from Nancy Rainwater and her welcoming committee.

**Changes this year:** Some of our flyers inadvertently did not include the **Friday Daylight pairs**. **Daylight pairs will be at 10 am on the Mezzanine level Wednesday through Friday.**

There will be **no free lunch** on Monday. Instead we will be spreading our hospitality money throughout the week.

The District finals of the Grand National Teams will be played here in Denver on

Saturday and Sunday, with Flight A and Superflight Finals on Monday if enough teams enter.

**Stratification:** Pairs and teams will be stratified according to average points. When you are playing in a Stratified event, your points will be averaged to determine in which strat your team or pair is placed. When you play in a stratified event, your team or pair must play in the flight where your highest point holder belongs, but you will be stratified within the flight according to average team or pair points.

**Covered Parking:**
